

BABY WRAPPER MODS

Make the **RIGHT FRONT first**.

After the shaping rows [ending with a K row], work **2 [4]** rows without shaping - break yarn and place these 14 [17] sts on a holder.

Make **LEFT FRONT next**.

After the shaping rows [ending with a P row], work **2 [4]** rows without shaping - do not break yarn.

Collect sts for **BACK** as follows:

With K side facing you, continuing with the **left front** sts, placing a marker at the first st to indicate the shoulder, K a row.

Make 22 [26] sts for the back neck one of 2 ways:

1. Using provisional method [with separate yarn], cast 22 [26] sts onto the left needle and continuing with the working yarn, K them.
2. **Continuing with the working yarn, cast 22 [26] sts onto the right needle using a half hitch stitch :**



With K side facing you, place sts from **right front** holder back on the left needle and continuing with the working yarn, K them, marking the last st to indicate shoulder.

FRONTS/BACK NECK EDGING

When collecting sts for fronts/back neck edging, depending on the cast on technique used for BACK NECK sts [above], either remove the provisional cast on row or **pick up the loops** of the half hitch cast on and add these 22 [26] sts to the needle.

Begin picking up sts - **starting with the left front edge, followed by the back neck and continuing along the right front.**
